Guided Study Information and Policies:

Guided studies are based on an existing course in the catalog, a student may request a guided study if the course may not be taken during the needed term or resolved in another manner. Guided studies are uncommon and treated as an exceptional privilege the student undertakes with the consent of a regular faculty member. The standards are equivalent to traditional course delivery. Guided studies are graded (A-F) courses. Guided studies are only taught during the traditional fall and spring semesters.

- The student must have a cumulative GPA of a 2.0
- A regular faculty member supervises the study
- The faculty member must arrange weekly, one-hour meetings at a fixed time to meet with the student
- Students may take no more than 12 credits of directed studies (not including internships) during their total university career and no more than one guided or independent study in a semester.

Students in a guided or independent study may not attend any course sessions of any course which they are not registered for, even if there is overlap in content.

Scheduled meeting times may not overlap with faculty instruction or student course enrollment.
